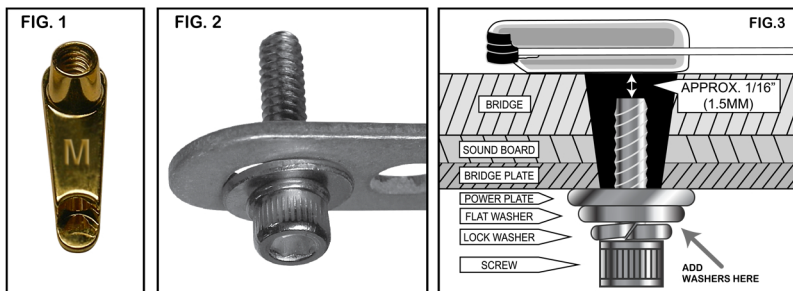
Installation and stringing procedure

- 1) Identify the pins, marked in 3 pairs. “B” for the two bass, “M” for the middle, and “T” for treble strings. (figure 1)
 - 2) Pre-assemble the power plate with 1 screw, 1 flat washer and 1 lock washer. (figure 2)
 - 3) Locate the bass low “E” pin hole from the inside of the guitar and push the screw tip up into the hole. Press the power plate and screw flat up against the bridge plate.
- IMPORTANT!** *The tip of the screw must be approximately 1/16” (1.5mm) below the surface of the bridge. If it protrudes too far into the slot it will interfere with stringing. If the screw tip is too high add washers until it is the proper distance below the surface of the bridge (see figure 3)*
- 4) Position a “B” Power Pin in the low E slot from the top and hand tighten the screw and pre-assembled plate from the inside. Leave the assembly fairly loose so that all the Power Pins can be easily aligned in the corresponding holes.
 - 5) Follow the same procedure install screw, washer and lock washer from below and Power Pin from above in the high E slot. Again, leave the assembly fairly loose.
 - 6) Mount the remaining Power Pins in the correct corresponding holes.
 - 7) Tighten the Screws with the supplied 7/64” allen wrench until snug. A small nudge on the wrench past snug is all that is necessary to keep the Power Pins properly positioned. Do not over-tighten.

Stringing:

- A) Pull each string past the end of the Power Pin until the double-windings clear the end of the pin.
- B) Move the body of the string into the chamber of the Power Pin.
- C) Secure the string by pulling the string until the ball end fully seats inside the end of the chamber.

Note: Heavier gauges and some silk and steel strings may be incompatible.

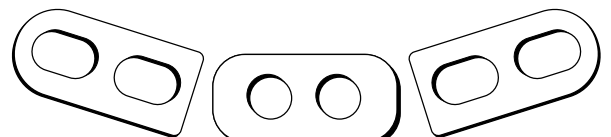
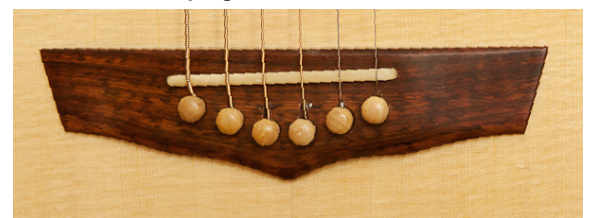


STRINGING PROCEDURE



Curved Bridge Instructions:

Cut Plate into 3 sections with a metal saw as shown below. Install keeping round holes in the middle.



CUT INTO 3 SECTIONS TO FIT CURVED BRIDGE. KEEP ROUND HOLES IN MIDDLE.
